In the modern periodic table, elements are listed by increasing Atomic #.

Each box represents an element. A box contains the name, atomic number, Chemical Symbol, and Atomic MASS for the element.

Vertical columns in the table are called Families (Groups). Most elements in a column have the same number of electrons in the outer energy level and tend to have similar properties.

Horizontal rows in the table are called periods. The elements on the left side of the table are metals. Groups 3-12 contain metals known as transition metals. Elements on the right side are Non-metals.
